The process is just as authentic as the ingredients and has remained unchanged across decades of production. If you're well versed in Italian spritz and the varieties thereof, the first signature serve is for you. The Limoncello Spritz includes 50ml of Limoncello DI CAPRI, 75ml of prosecco, and 25ml of soda (over ice of course) – accompanied by a sprig of mint and a twist of lemon. An excellent option for special occasions which require a little extra fizz. And don't be fooled into believing that Limoncello DI CAPRI is purely a summer drink, the warming effect of the rich citrus flavour is enjoyed along the Amalfi coast in winter, just as it is in summer – a habit which we here in the UK could do with adopting throughout the cold winter months.

The next signature serve makes for the perfect aperitivo – a refreshingly long and crisp beverage that will transport you to Italy's dramatic south-western coastline. Mix 50ml of Limoncello DI CAPRI with 100ml of tonic water and pour over ice. Garnish with a sprig of mint, a slice of lemon and there you have one thirst-quenching tipple.
