The marula fruit has a rich heritage – the trees have grown for thousands of years across Africa's subequatorial plains, including South Africa. At the start of each year, the local community are alerted to the harvest season by elephants. The elephants play a key role in the production of Amarula which is why they feature on all the bottles.

To support elephant conservation, 'The Amarula Trust' was launched in 2008. This charitable arm of Amarula strengthens and empowers communities and builds a sustainable future within the marula fruit ecosystem and beyond.

Amarula Cream is best served over ice and preferably enjoyed during the festive season with friends and family. Enjoy the infectious spirit that allows you to revel in 'being carefree'.

Amarula Cream is 17% ABV and is available to purchase for £12.50 from Amazon and Tesco.
