## PLAYMOBIL 1.2.3 & Disney – Playsets inspired by Disney's Mickey Mouse & Winnie the Pooh

There is a lot to discover in **Winnie's & Piglet's Tree House**: Different items can be sorted into the treetop by shape and colour to develop fine motor skills and three-dimensional thinking. A hidden slide lets the objects reappear at the bottom of the tree - providing lots of fun. There are also many other details to explore: For example, turn the small group of leaves to make noises or take the second group of leaves and convert it into a spinning top toy. The adorable Disney characters encourage children to tell their own stories during first role play.

The bees are on the loose in **Winnie's & Tigger's Bee Garden!** Inserting the bee sticks into the honey pots promotes fine motor skills. To make the bees fly, just press and release the sticks. Tigger's cave is the perfect place to play hide and seek and sliding is always fun, too. Planting colourful flowers helps to improve fine motor skills as well.

**Winnie's Counter Balance Honey Pot** is the starter set in the corresponding product line, inspired by Disney's Winnie the Pooh. It playfully promotes fine motor skills and cognitive thinking at the same time. After nudging the honeypot, it always gets back up and wobbles back and forth.

Mickey's & Minnie's Cloud Home is an explorative play set supporting the development of toddlers in various ways: The different combination possibilities stimulate creative thinking. For example, the rainbow can be used as a seesaw as well as a rattle, but it can also be combined with the rainbow building blocks to form a colourful archway. Lots of puzzle and plug-in features, like the

raindrop staircase, develop both fine motor and cognitive skills. The cute Disney characters inspire first role play and creative stories.

Mickey's & Minnie's Cloud Ride is a plug-in and combination game, that promotes fine motor and cognitive skills at the same time. The individual snap-lock elements and vehicles can be combined as the child wishes, to create a fun plane-cloud-train. The printed pods also encourage children to learn to count from 1 to 3. Or, with the help of their parents, they can also get to know how a rainbow develops, for example.

Mickey's Spinning Sun with Rattle Feature is the starter set for the youngest fans of the corresponding PLAYMOBIL 1.2.3 product line inspired by Disney's Mickey Mouse. It playfully develops fine motor skills. The built-in rattling sound catches the curiosity of little explorers.
