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Born in 1903, Lily Blanche lived a remarkable life, raising four children in India during the 1930s. Upon returning to Britain at the onset of

WWII, her home was destroyed in the Blitz. She relocated to Scotland, where she fell in love with the rugged beauty of the landscape.

Lily Blanche was a skilled creator, crafting with the precision of a professional - whether it was cooking, sewing, knitting, or crocheting. My memories of her island home, filled with exotic keepsakes from her travels, remain a source of inspiration. After studying archaeology at Edinburgh University, where I focused on ancient jewellery and metalwork techniques, I began to develop my own designs.

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At the heart of every Lily Blanche piece are the themes of sentiment, meaning, and connection. Jewellery is a powerful link

to the past - a gift passed through generations, filled with the stories of those who wore it before. We strive to create the heirlooms of tomorrow from the conversation pieces of today.
