But what hue to choose? Bernard Delettrez, the Italian fine jeweller, suggests 'Go with the flow – buy on instinct. The charm of the Amethyst is that it has so many variations – the Brazilian stones have a lighter hue, those from the Karaiba mine in Africa are a deep rich colour and stones from the Anahí mine in Bolivia are shot with citrine. My pieces feature stones from all over the world, although my favourites are from Africa. I especially love Amethysts for their remarkable depth and shades of colour and warmth.'

And for those looking for affordable gifts, Bernard Delettrez's finely worked fashion pieces such as this Bronze Butterfly Ring (£180) and the Gold circlet earrings with diamonds (£1230) are just the ticket.
